

The Crown Point Press Summer Etching Workshop 2023

We are pleased to offer three workshops this summer.

Week 1: June 19-23 Week 2: June 26-30 Week 3: July 10-14

Instruction focuses on getting good results from the medium; aesthetic advice is not given. Participants work independently with instruction and guidance from our three printers, all of whom are master printers.

Each workshop runs Monday through Friday, from 9 AM - 5 PM. There is no access to the studio before or after hours. *Note: Participation in studio clean-up is expected on Friday afternoons. Please plan your travel plans accordingly.*

The workshop fee is \$2000 per week. Copper and paper (which we supply) are charged based on use. You will be invoiced at the end of the workshop for the materials you use.

To apply, please send a completed application (on the second page) and submit a photo of your proof of vaccination to <u>Sasha Baguskas</u>, our workshop administrator. We will notify you about your placement on February 15. See this letter's second page for payment details. We will accept applications through February 15 or until the workshops are full. We do not accept applications via phone. We will send you confirmation of your placement by email on February 15. Payment is due in full within 48 hours of acceptance and it guarantees your participation.

COVID Protocols during the workshop: Workshop participants must include, in their application, proof of vaccination and booster. Emailed photos of both will be sufficient. Workshop participants must wear N95 masks at all times in the Crown Point studio. These will be provided. We will encourage social distancing.

CANCELLATION POLICY: The fee for the week-long workshop is \$2000 not including the costs of paper and copper which are tallied and billed to you after the workshop, based on use. If you cancel before May 1, we will refund half the workshop fee (\$1000). If you cancel after that date for any reason, we will keep the entire fee.
